How to take part:

2 Read the book.
... both of you

3 Mark your diary – Tuesday 24th July, 6:00 – 7:30 pm
... to bring your daughter to the Mt Alvernia iCentre for a Pizza and author night where you will have the opportunity to listen to Michael Gerard Bauer, the author of *Don't Call me Ishmael*.
