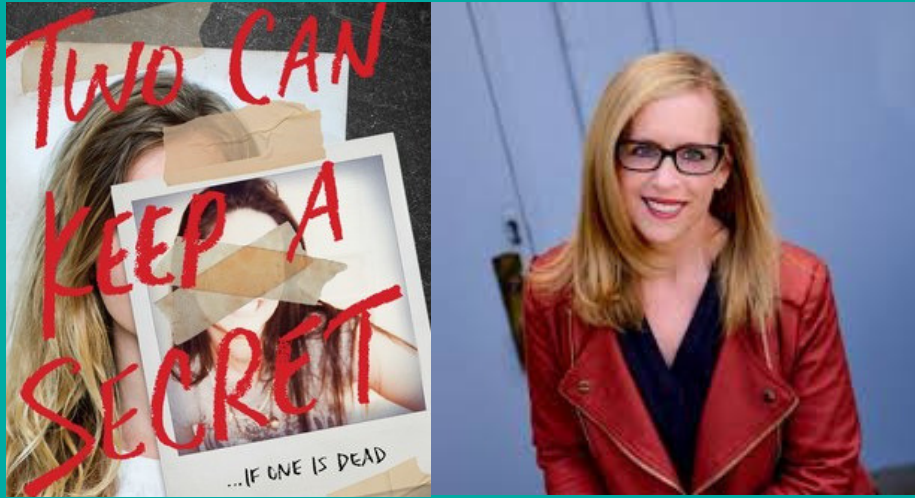


Two Can Keep a Secret

It's a murder mystery that is full of suspense and plot twists that will have you reading furiously to the end.



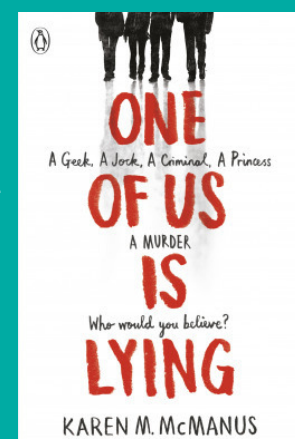
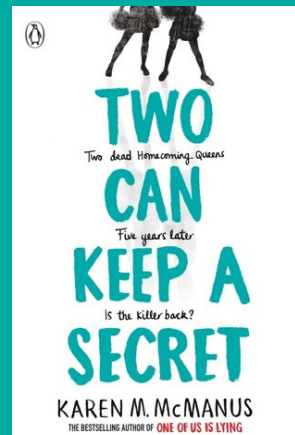
It's the combination of page-turning plot and interesting characters that will hook the reader into this riveting read
