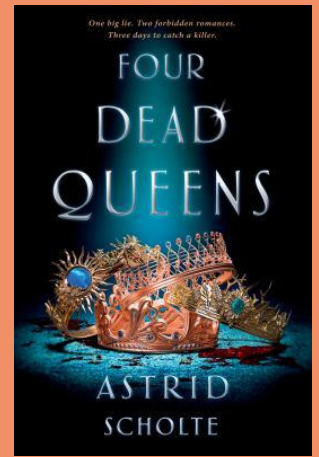


Four Dead Queens
